

Mowing

Recently, the District has received numerous inquiries regarding the mowing schedule. The contract with Cepra depicts (28) mowings for low visibility ponds/low maintenance turf, along with the discretion on environmental/physical conditions of the turf and soil. During frequent rain events, the sandy soil is relatively soggy which prohibits a mower from gliding smoothly over the turf. When these conditions occur, while it is not aesthetically pleasing, it is quite beneficial to the turf as it allows it to “go to seed.” The seeds assist in replenishing the turf which is ideal for the pond banks, the District, and the budget.

When Cepra is prohibited from mowing due to environmental/physical conditions, they mow an extra time or two throughout the calendar year as permitted. This is standard operating procedure with all landscape companies throughout the state.
